8.1 Purpose. This chapter describes the relationship between the Division of Safety and Risk Management and Indian Tribes under the Indian Highway Safety Program (IHSP).

8.2 Policy. The Bureau policy is to administer the Indian Highway Safety Program for the purpose of furnishing assistance to Indian tribes so they may benefit from programs authorized by the U.S. Department of Transportation.

8.3 Administration. The Program is administrated by the Division of Safety and Risk Management. The Division Chief has been designated Program Administrator and the Governor's Representative for Highway Safety. The Secretary of the Interior is designated 'Governor of the Indian State'.
