ORDER NO. 3320

Subject: Implementation of Recommendations from the *Report for the Secretary on the Proposed BLM/OSM Consolidation*.

**Sec. 1 Purpose.** This Order directs implementation of the recommendations of the *Report for the Secretary on the Proposed BLM/OSM Consolidation* (Report). This will enable the Office of Surface Mining Reclamation and Enforcement (OSM) to pursue administrative and program consolidations with the Bureau of Land Management (BLM), the Office of Natural Resources Revenue (ONRR), and other appropriate Department of the Interior (DOI) organizations to generate savings and efficiencies, and improve government effectiveness, while continuing to remain an independent bureau within the Department. These efforts shall be in coordination with the Department's Service First initiatives on consolidations.

**Sec. 2 Background.** Secretary's Order No. 3315, entitled Office of Surface Mining Reclamation and Enforcement Consolidated and Established within the Bureau of Land Management, was issued on October 26, 2011. It directed the consolidation and/or realignment of OSM and BLM. SO 3315 was supplemented and amended by Secretary's Order No. 3316, which was entitled Supplement and Amendment to Secretarial Order No. 3315, and was issued on November 28, 2011. SO 3316 directed the creation of the Report and changed the implementation date of SO 3315.


**Sec. 3 Authority.** This Order is issued in accordance with the authority provided by section 2 of Reorganization Plan No. 3 of 1950 (64 Stat. 1262).

**Sec. 4 Implementation.**

a. The Directors of the BLM, OSM, and ONRR shall develop a workplan and a timetable to implement the Secretary's decisions regarding consolidation. The workplan, which will be approved by the Deputy Secretary, shall reflect the importance of moving forward expeditiously to institute the Secretary's decisions regarding consolidation of operations affecting OSM, BLM, ONRR, and other DOI organizations, as appropriate.

b. The realignment of funding and people shall occur coincident with the start of the fiscal year and subsequent to approval by the Office of Management and Budget and Appropriations Committees.

Sec. 5 **Expiration Date.** This Order is effective immediately and supersedes SO 3315 and SO 3316. It will remain in effect until it is amended, superseded, or revoked, whichever occurs first.
