Sir or Madam,

On March 13 of this year, *nā kanaka maoli* -- commonly identified as "native Hawaiians" - - from all corners of the Hawaiian Islands reinstated the lawful Hawaiian Government of the de jure Hawaiian Nation after an absence of one-hundred six years. This government was in a state of impairment since its unlawful coup d'état by insurrectionists in 1893. Using the law of nations, United States public law and Hawaiian Kingdom law, a provisional government was established to pursue permanent Nation status.

In simple terms, the true and rightful government of Hawai'i has returned from exile.

Be advised of the legal significance of this monumental effort. The re-establishment of this government means the transition of sovereign authority from the 'awful State of Hawai'i and its patron, the United States government, is underway.

This de jure Hawaiian Government has two immediate objectives:

- 1) repatriate *nā kanaka maoli* from their current status as U.S. nationals to their rightful status as citizens of the de jure Hawaiian Nation, and
- 2) conduct a free and open election to send their duly-elected representatives to serve in the permanent Hawaiian Government.

To understand the powers manifested by this government, I am willing to share the points of fact and the authority of law substantiating our claim. Enclosed in this envelope is a press kit prepared by the Office of Communication -- the agency handling media relations for the Lawful Hawaiian Government.
