>To whom it may concern:

>

>My name is Patrick L. Fishell, I was born in Hawai'i and am part kanaka

>maoli (native hawaiian), and can trace ancestry to the indigenous people

>that populated the Hawaiian moku (island) o' Kaua'i before the arrival of

>peoples of European ancestry. I currently dwell on the land of Arizona near

>the Phoenix area of Maricopa county.

>

>Public Law 103-150 was a long time in coming and long over due. There is

>voluminous factual information and opinions by numerous historians and

legal

>scholars, starting with President Cleveland, who draw upon those facts to

>voice the opinion that the annexation of Hawai'i did not lawfully take

place

>. Facts which prove that the United States willfully and knowingly

violated

>not only its own Supreme Laws but those of the international community

known

>as the Law of Nations. Even members of the U.S. Department of Justice hold

>the opinion that the takeover of the Hawaiian Kingdom was in violation of

>the Law.

>

>In the selfish interests of an elite few, self interested empire builders,

>who professed to have America's interest in mind, the demise of a peaceful

>and friendly nation (which held treaties with the U.S. that are still in

>force according to the law of nations and plain old ordinary contract law)

>was engineered. It was common knowledge to all the kanaka maoli peers that

>grew up with that our land and country was STOLEN by the foreigners.

>

>Title and CONTROL of the lands of the Hawaiian people was STOLEN through

>fraud and deception. If a living soul commits such a crime it is labeled as

>larceny by fraud or deception. Once the crime is discovered, that

individual

>is caused to pay dearly for the crime perpetrated. The crime in this case

>has been admitted to but the perpetrator blatantly continues to exercise

>control over OUR property and our persons. How shall the U.S. be caused to

>pay, make restitution for, the crime and, ALL the
>repercussions and the
>suffering of the kanaka maoli people which have taken place
>over these 106
>years??? It is a huge responsibility. I believe the U.S.
>government is not
>up to the task of doing or even contemplating the RIGHT THING.
>
>The facts unerringly show the wrongs committed. Mr. Berry and
>many others
>know the facts and there is no need to cite them here. An
>admission of
>wrong
>doing by the U.S. has been Public Law for years now. The U.S.
>and the
>American people have a responsibility to assist, and not
>hinder, the
>re-establishment of the de-jure government of the Hawai'ian
>Nation. This
>talk by the B.I.A. and your D.O.J., of native american
>(no)status for the Hawaiian People has no foundation and is
>just another
>smoke screen and delay tactic for and by the U.S. to put off
>doing what
>has, for over 106 years, been called for. We want our right to
>self
>determination, which is now being held hostage by the U.S.,
>and our country
>back. Let my People go in peace!
