**TOPIC: Submission of Written Testimony on Topics: (1) Hawaiian Land and Natural Resources; (2) Native Hawaiian Culture and Economic Development; (3) Political Relationship; (4) Reconciliation Process; (5) Emil Wolfgramm Indication to Serve as a Member on Reconciliation Committee.**

I hereby humbly present my written testimony as a preliminary indication of my right to be involved in the federal US Reconciliation Process and Native Hawaiians on the following issues as it pertains to myself and our relatives and descendants as well as our progenitors in the following topics in the respective areas of reconciliation.

**(1) Hawaiian Land and Natural Resources:** In behalf of Mary K. Forsythe Akimo, Margaret Kamake'e Forsythe Larsen, their siblings, and all their descendants thier land claim to the following sites: (a) Hickam Air Force Base, (b) Fort Kamehameha, (c) and all other land properties directly associated with their land holding progenitors, (d) In behalf of descendants of Sylvester Cullen and Mary Holbron regarding the all confiscated lands in the area of Waiahole Valley, O'ahu, and other lands of ownership including, (i) Claimed family home site in Waiahole, (ii) Kane'ohe Bay site at mouth of Waiahole Valley, and (iii) other lands of ownership.

**(2) Native Hawaiian Culture and Economic Development:** To develop an economic development program founded upon the ancient Polynesian and Hawaiian view of mana as expressed through the traditional customary ways and rituals connected to the malae. The re-establishment and use of the traditional malae would found the ancient world view of the Hawaiian and its connects to other Polynesian and non-Polynesian traditional groups thereby providing the foundation for modern foundation for modern economic development models and commercial operations, thereby providing a supportive revenue stream based upon traditional cultural values.

**(3) Political Relationship:** The final political relationship be nation (The Kingdom of Hawai'i) to nation (USA). That the national status of the Kingdom of Hawai'i be returned to the Hawaiian peoples and that they be made whole once more.

**(4) Reconciliation Process:**

And that this Political Relationship be defined, established, and implemented in 14-months before the end of President Bill Clinton's administration.

**(5) Emil Wolfgramm Indication to Serve as a Member on Reconciliation Committee:** Emil Wolfgramm hereby indicates his willingness to serve as member of the Reconciliation Committee.
