The Republic of the Marshall Islands' Office of the Auditor-General (OAG) is soliciting written proposals for Certified Public Accountant (CPA) Training and Consulting Services. The OAG requires the services of an individual who has the knowledge, skill, and experience in providing training and consultations on generally accepted accounting principles and generally accepted government auditing standards in relation to audits of state and local governments and/or municipalities. The service shall consist primarily of providing on-the-job training to OAG staff, reviewing, advising, and evaluating a wide range of issues concerning audits.

Proposals should be prepared simply and economically, providing straightforward, concise descriptions of the Offeror's ability to fulfill the requirements of the proposal. In order to ensure a uniform review process and to obtain the maximum degree of comparability, it is required that proposals be organized and submitted in the manner prescribed in the RFP.

To be considered, all proposals must be submitted with one (1) original and three (3) copies by **12 PM (Noon), Monday, January 23rd, 2012, to OAG. Proposals must be mailed or hand-delivered to the address indicated in the RFP. Proposals submitted after the 12:00 PM (Majuro Time), Monday, January 23rd, 2012 deadline will not be considered.**
