

ORDER

WHEREAS the Act of July 1, 1932 (47 Stat. 564; 25 U.S.C. 386a), authorizes the Secretary of the Interior to adjust or eliminate reimbursable charges of the United States existing as debts against tribes of Indians in a just and equitable way considering the circumstances under which the charges were made; and

WHEREAS, a report of the Acting Director, Office of Tribal Resources Development, dated JUN 12, 1973 shows that the debt listed below should be cancelled because the collection would be unjust and inequitable;

NOW, THEREFORE, I hereby cancel such debt or such part thereof as may be unpaid at the time this Order is effective and notice thereof is received by the officers in charge of field jurisdictions where the accounts are of record. This Order shall be effective 60 legislative days after the annual report for the current fiscal year has been made to Congress as required by the Act of July 1, 1932, unless Congress in the meantime has taken unfavorable action thereon:
