FEDERAL TRAVEL REGULATION  
GSA BULLETIN FTR 06-05

TO: Heads of Federal Agencies

SUBJECT: The extension of the effective dates for FTR Bulletins 05-06 and 05-07, regarding reimbursement for actual subsistence expenses, and waivers of certain provisions of the Federal Travel Regulation (FTR) (41 CFR parts 301 and 302) for temporary duty (TDY), or relocation travel of employees to areas impacted by Hurricanes Katrina and Rita.

1. Purpose. This Bulletin informs agencies that as the conditions that prompted FTR Bulletins 05-06 and 05-7 continue, the effective dates for those Bulletins are being extended.

The provisions in FTR Bulletins 05-06 and 05-07 became effective on August 29, 2005 and September 24, 2005 respectively. Both of these bulletins were originally slated to expire on March 1, 2006. They are being extended as stated in paragraph 2.

2. Expiration dates. This Bulletin extends the expiration date for FTR Bulletins 05-06 and 05-07 from March 1, 2006, to September 30, 2006, unless further extended or rescinded by this office.
