









HONOLULU DISTRICT AREA OF RESPONSIBILITY


- Feasibility studies to investigate structural and non-structural solutions to water resource challenges
 - Large and small in scale, using our different business lines as necessary to support our partners and the communities we serve
 - Lead to design and construction if a recommended plan is approved and funded
- Watershed studies to create a strategic watershed management plan with recommendations and prioritization for implementation
- Technical assistance in planning and community resilience
 - Hazard mitigation planning, managed retreat planning, storm drainage analysis, coastal atlas, Flood Insurance Rate Map updates, coral reef studies, Floodplain Management Plans, etc.




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REGULATORY

Authorities

- Sec. 10 Rivers & Harbors Act of 1899: Any Structures/Work in or Affecting Navigable Waters (Pacific Ocean, harbors, tidal inlets/outlets, and Colorado River)
- Sec. 404 Clean Water Act of 1972:
 Discharges of Dredged or Fill
 Material into Waters of the U.S.
 (Navigable waters, tributaries, and associated wetlands)
