


Veterans Affairs Pacific Island Health Care System (VAPIHCS)

 - CBOC's Serve as a Medical Home
 - VAPIHCS Supported by DoD, VA Partner Facilities
 - TAMC in Honolulu; USNH Guam; VA Hospitals VISN 21 in Northern California/Nevada
 - Local State and Private Hospitals, Physicians, Laboratories



VAPIHCS CBOC CAPABILITIES

- Primary Care Team: MD, APRN, LPN, Administrative Support
- Specialty Support by Visiting Specialists and / or V-tel
- Mental Health Team: MD, Social Worker, APRN, Addiction Therapist
- Home Health Care: RN, Social Worker
- Technology Support: Video; Monitoring Devices for Physiologic Monitoring; Interactive Devices



VA Provided Tools

VA developed Electronic Health Record

- Demographic Data; Problem List; Provider Notes; Consultations; Hospital Discharge Summaries; VA Provided Drugs; Order Entry; Results Reporting (Graphing / Table Creation)
- Data Searchable and Computable
- Relatively Intuitive Front End
- Supports Measurement of Quality Monitors and Clinical Reminders Based on Patient Demographics and ICD-9 Codes
- Remote Data View

 Drug Management - National Drug Database - Order Checks Check Against Allergies Adverse Drug Reactions Adverse Drug Interaction - CMOP Mail Out Pharmacy - Automatic Dispensing System (in CBOC)
