Subject: Erratum for Initial Fiscal Year 2024 Budget Allocations for Implementing the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (Public Law 117-58)

**Purpose:** This document is an erratum for Policy Memorandum (PM) No. 2024-002, which provides information and direction regarding the first round of allocations of Fiscal Year 2024 funding for implementing the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act, or “Bipartisan Infrastructure Law”, Public Law 117-58.

Table 1 on page 5 of PM No. 2024-002 contains an incorrect number. The number on the row for “Fuels Management Projects/Programs of Work (FY 2024)” under the column “TOTAL by Activity or Subactivity” was incorrectly listed as 94,101. The correct number is 106,867. Other numbers in the table, which represent Dollars in thousands, remain unchanged. This is the only change to PM No. 2024-002.

B/ These allocations are additional funding for BIL Section 40803(d)(4): the special pay supplements for federal wildland firefighters (the same purpose as allocations in DOI Wildland Fire Program PMs 2022-007, 2022-008, 2023-002, 2023-006, 2023-007, and 2023-008). All of this funding is from FY 2022 funding that the USDA Forest Service transferred to Interior. The amounts in this table do not include funding appropriated by another law to continue these pay supplements: P.L. 118-15, the Continuing Appropriations Act, 2024 and Other Extensions Act (a.k.a., the first CR of FY 2024).

C/ OWF will transfer amounts from these approved allocations for FY 2024 when eligible projects are identified and approved by the bureau.

D/ The full amount was made available to NPS in DOI Wildland Fire Program PM 2023-007, so there is no additional allocation for NPS for BAR at this time.
