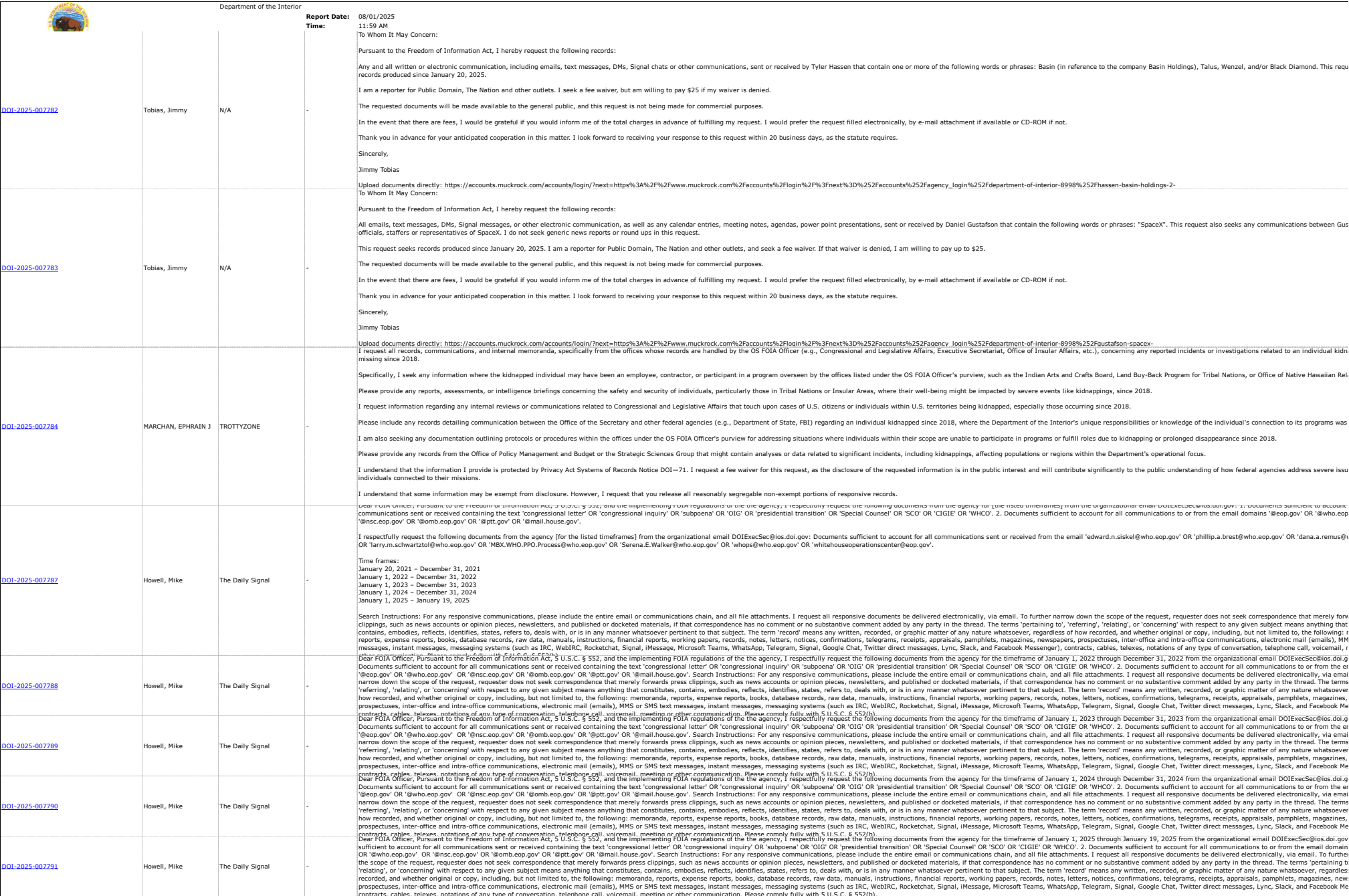

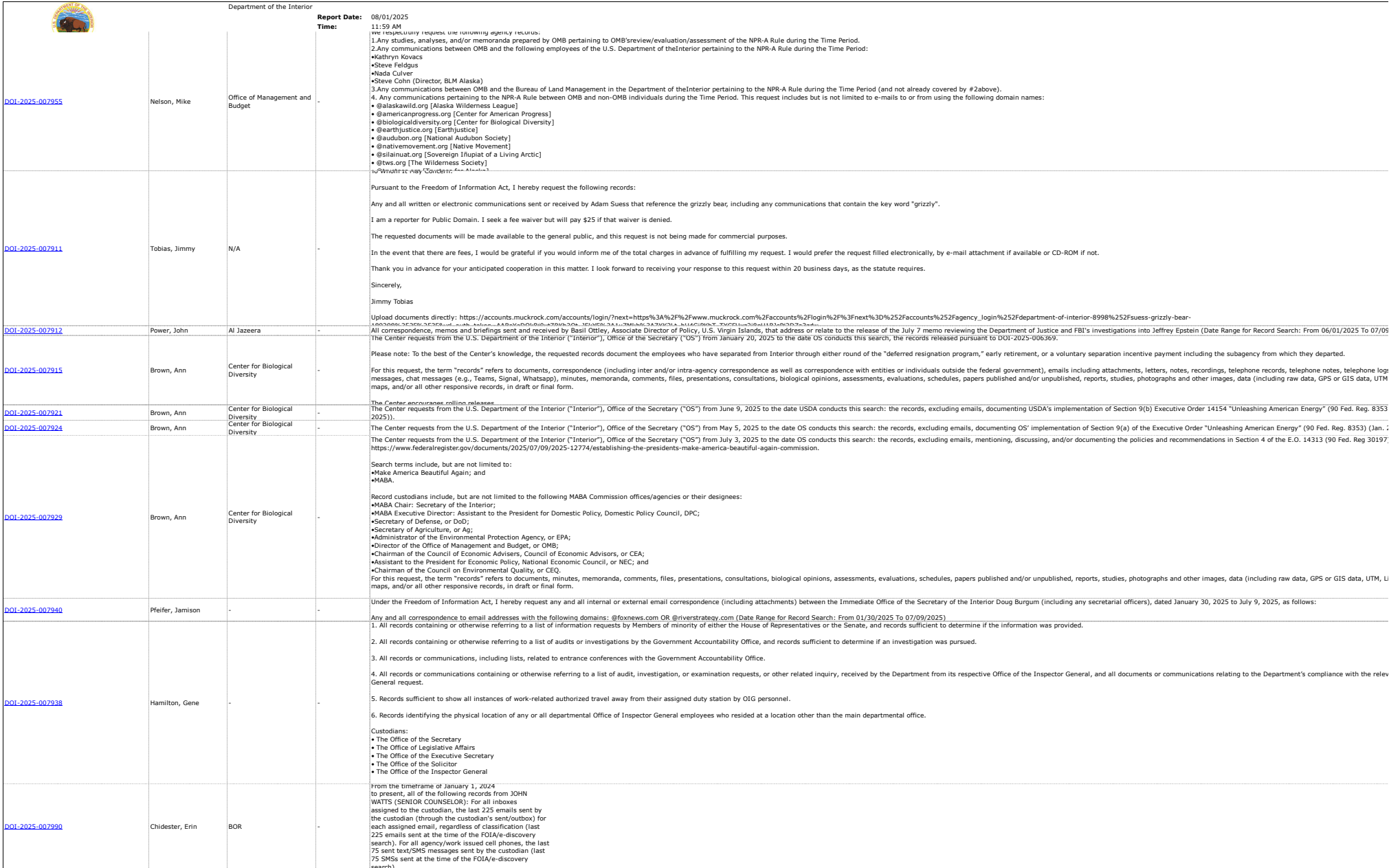



Assessing Coal Resources and Accessibility on Federal Land 60 days of the date of this order, the Secretary of the Interior, the Secretary of Agriculture, and the Secretary of Energy shall submit a consolidated report to the President through the Assistant to the President for Economic Policy that identifies coal resources and reserves on Federal lands, assesses impediments to mining resources, and proposes policies to address such impediments and ultimately enable the mining of such coal resources by either private or public actors.

A copy of the meeting agenda, meeting minutes, and meeting handouts for each meeting of the National Energy Dominance Council since February 1, 2025. I also request a copy of the plan to raise awareness on a national level of matters related to energy dominance, and other written recommendations from the Council request any written materials originated by the Council and its meetings regarding Small Modular Nuclear Reactors. These records are requested from the Office of the Secretary of the Interior, who is the Chairman of the Council.

The Executive Order entitled: Immediate Measures to Increase American Mineral Production, dated March 20, 2025, stated: Sec. 5. Land Use for Mineral Projects. (a) Within 10 days of the date of this order, the Secretary of the Interior shall identify and provide the Assistant to the President for Economic Policy and the President for National Security Affairs with a list of all Federal lands known to hold mineral deposits and reserves. I request a copy of the list of Federal lands known to hold mineral deposits and reserves, prepared by the Secretary of the Interior.

A copy of meeting agendas and meeting minutes and meeting handouts from the D.C. Safe and Beautiful Task Force, in which the Department of the Interior participates, as described in the President's Executive Order dated March 28, 2025 titled "Making the District of Columbia Safe and Beautiful".
