NEPA applies to all "major federal action significantly affecting the quality of the human environment." 42 U.S.C. 4321(2)(C). The Council on Environmental Quality have consistently termed interpreted the mandate broadly encompassing not only physical projects, but also programmatic decisions, pol cie and actions that alter how federal agencies carry out their statutory responsibilities. A mass firing of thousands of federal employees within land management, environmental protection and regulatory agencies const tutes a major federal action subject to NEPA because of its scale, scope and foreseeable environmental consequences. The Department of Interior cannot avoid NEPA by labeling this decision as "budgetary" or "personnel" when it has substantive environmental consequences. 5 CFR 351.203 defines "reorganization" as "the planned elimination, addition, or redistribution of functions or duties in an organization." An agency reorganization on this scale is a "major federal action" subject to substantial federal control; therefore an agency is required to analyze the direct effects of elimination or reduction of functions as per NEPA before they implement the action.
