





Subject: Authorization for Use of Government Passenger Carriers for Home-to-Work Transportation

**Purpose:** This Policy Memorandum establishes Home-to-Work transportation authority for Bureau fire management and response personnel. These Home-to-Work authorizations are for fieldwork activities and are only granted under the conditions and positions listed in Attachments 1 and 2.

**Background:** On September 2, 2015, Secretary of the Interior signed the Authorization for Use of Government Passenger carriers for Home-to-Work Transportation (Attachment 1) of those employees essential for the safe and efficient performance of Wildland Fire response. Attached is a copy of the approved authorization for your immediate implementation.

**Scope:** Attachment 1 of the Authorization designates 304 specific positions that are authorized for Home-to-Work transportation. Each bureau is responsible for ensuring that only those specific positions utilize the authorized Home-to-Work use of Government motor vehicles. The authorization is valid for two years at which point it must be reviewed and updated for recertification by the designated bureau official. Bureau fire executives and fire directors shall monitor and track usage in preparation for updating and recertification.

**Time Frame:** This Policy Memorandum is effective immediately and remains in effect until rescinded or modified.

**Policy:** Each bureau must complete the following in implementing this Authorization:

1. Provide a directive to each person authorized the use of Government vehicles for Home-to-Work transportation. The directive will require that each person be vigilant in ensuring that vehicles are used only for the official purposes intended and will caution that every effort must be taken to preclude the perception that such use is not official. Substantiated incidents of misuse will result in disciplinary action.

2. Require that each person authorized the use of a Government vehicle for Home-to-Work transportation maintains a log or record to verify that such use was for official purposes.
3. Each bureau will decide the organizational level at which the determinations, directives, logs, or other records shall be maintained. These documents should be readily and easily accessible for audit purposes.
4. Establish a procedure for providing management oversight of the use of Government vehicles for Home-to-Work transportation. The procedures shall include provisions for management review and audits of written authorization determinations, directives, and logs or records.

Future Home-to-Work requests should be submitted to this office for review and will be considered at the time appropriate to recertify/amend the current authorization. At the time to update and recertify the current authorization, each bureau is required to confirm the need for each determination to justify the continued use of Government vehicles for Home-to-Work transportation.

As part of its responsibilities for oversight of the Department's wildland fire management program this office will monitor implementation of this authorization.

## DECISION MEMORANDUM FOR THE SECRETARY

Subject: Authorization for Use of Government Passenger Carriers for Home-to-Work  
Transportation

### I. INTRODUCTION

Current Federal regulations preclude employees from taking Government vehicles home; they are to be housed at the work site. There are limited exceptions to these regulations, but approval can only be granted by the Secretary and cannot be delegated.

This memorandum seeks your approval for fire management and response personnel (in fire bureaus) to take their vehicles home to be prepared for response during high fire danger periods. Immediate access to their vehicles would allow these personnel to respond quickly to fire incidents. We have identified specific protocols for employees to ensure they maintain records for auditing purposes.

### II. BACKGROUND

Federal regulations relating to the management and use of Government fleet contained in 41 Code of Federal Regulations, Chapter 102, disallow the use of vehicles for "home-to-work" travel. Rather, the regulations require that Government-owned vehicles be garaged at an office site or an alternate Government-owned or leased site. These restrictions are imposed to ensure employees do not use Government vehicles for their personal use and to comply with property management requirements.

Home-to-work authorizations can only be granted by the head of the agency, the Secretary, and cannot be delegated. Authorizations can be granted for up to 2 years. Authorizations require employees to be engaging in field work, facing a clear and present danger, responding to an emergency, or they must justify a compelling operational consideration. There are significant record keeping and reporting requirements that accompany these designations.

In this case, we are seeking authorizations to support the fire program to increase response time, and contribute to improved effectiveness and efficiency. We are not designating individuals, but rather key positions that can exercise this authority.



We request designation of the following positions:

- 137 Fire Management Officers
- 76 Assistant Fire Management Officers
- 91 Fire Operations Specialist

### III. POSITON OF INTERESTED PARTIES

The action to designate these positions for access to home-to-work privileges with Government-owned vehicles will improve the effectiveness and efficiency of the fire program. Employees will be able to dispatch from their residences to fire sites without having to go to the office to get a Government-owned vehicle. This improved access is expected to improve response times and facilitate the protection of life.

Bureau Directors are in support of the designation and have accepted the requirements for additional record keeping and reporting. Other Federal agencies have adopted this same approach and are seeing it as a successful practice.

With continuing vigilance to ensure appropriate record keeping and reporting and appropriate oversight by supervisors, we believe there is minimal risk. If instances of misuse are determined, the authorization would be withdrawn for the individual and potentially for the reporting unit. The fact that other agencies are currently using this approach is an important consideration.

### IV. DESCISION OF OPTIONS

- Approve the request to designate 304 positions for home-to-work privileges;
- Disapprove the request; or
- Approve a subset of the request or an alternative approach.

### V. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend that you approve this request. The Office of Wildland Fire has worked with the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Bureau of Land Management, U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, and National Park Service to develop the accountability protocols.

## **Attachment 2**

### **Department of the Interior Wildland Fire Management Program Home-to-Work Transportation Authorization FY 2015 Request Record**

In accordance with the Department of the Interior Motor Vehicle Management Handbook (April 2008), the following information is included in the request for authorization to use a Government passenger carrier for home-to-work-transportation:

(1) Job title and series number: The designated wildland fire program management positions include: Fire Management Officers (GS-0401), Assistant Fire Management Officers (GS-0401), and Fire Operations Specialists (GS-401/0455/0462).

(2) Duties of the position(s) which require the authorization: The positions designated may require the use of motor vehicles for the safe and efficient performance of field duties, which can include initial response to wildland fires for establishing command and control, and/or providing other leadership and oversight in an emerging incident.

The specific field duties of the Fire Management Officer (FMO) and Assistant Fire Management Officer (AFMO) positions include, but are not limited to:

- (a) coordinates and initiates on wildland fires all fire management activities based on firefighter and public safety, cost effectiveness, and values to be protected consistent with resource objectives, by using the full range of strategic and tactical options as described in an approved Fire Management Plan.

- b) coordinates operations with cooperating agencies on multi-jurisdictional wildland fires addressing risk to human safety and potential for damages to resources and improvements.

- (c) manages the environmental and workplace hazards of the wildland fire environment and provides leadership and direction to subordinates in the recognition and mitigation of these hazards.

- (d) responsible for the on-the-job safety and health of all employees supervised.

The specific field duties of the Fire Operations Specialist (FOS) position include, but are not limited to:

- (a) assigns missions to ground and aviation wildland fire suppression resources. Makes efficient and effective use of multiple types of interagency wildland fire suppression resources with varying capabilities. Ensures common communications for interagency resources.

- (b) provides protection for life, property and resources. Selects strategies and tactics to ensure safe operations for assigned resources. Recognizes potential hazardous situations and provides operational briefings. Initiates contacts with federal, state, and/or local law

enforcement personnel as necessary to close roads, evacuate structures, and deal with the public.

(c) participates in development of incident objectives and strategies and tactics, to provide for safe operations and cost effective incident management.

(3) The address of the permanent duty station: The information is provided in the table below.

(4) Type of passenger carrier: The information is provided in the table below.

(5) Justification – clearly citing the beneficial effects of work performance and expected results:

Use of Government passenger carriers for home-to-work transportation by those employee(s) occupying the described positions will substantially increase the efficiency and economy of the Department of the Interior under the circumstances described:

(a) extreme fire danger and/or high potential for above normal fire growth exists where an immediate response can directly reduce the damage to property and resources as well as limit the complexity of an emerging fire which results in lower threats to public and firefighter safety.

(b) response to wildland fire emergencies, or other circumstances, where there is an immediate, unforeseeable, temporary need to provide home-to-work transportation for the uninterrupted performance of the agency's mission, such as during periods of extreme fire danger.

(c) establishing command and control and/or providing fireline leadership in an emerging incident that results in minimizing exposure to firefighters and the public. The need for competent, qualified oversight on all fires is a key factor in reducing the risk profile.
