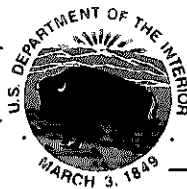

EXPLANATION OF MATERIAL TRANSMITTED:

This Departmental Manual Release updates the functional description for the Office of the Deputy Director – Justice Services (130 DM 4). The organizational changes strengthen management and administration of the office and improve delivery of services and accountability. Significant changes include:

- Establishing the Division of Emergency Management, the Division of Internal Affairs, and Department of Justice Liaison position reporting to the Assistant Deputy Director.
- Establishing four (4) new Directorates headed by Associate Directors: Field Operations, Professional Standards, Tribal Justice Support, and Support Services.
- Establishing the Division of Drug Enforcement and the Division of Indian Highway Safety under the Field Operations Directorate.
- Renaming the Division of Law Enforcement Services, the Division of Law Enforcement; and realigning the Division of Law Enforcement and the Division of Corrections under the Field Operations Directorate.
- Establishing a Victim Assistance Program under the Tribal Justice Support Directorate.
- Establishing the Inspections Division and realigning the Indian Police Academy under the Director, Professional Standards.
- The Division of Professional Standards is abolished and the program functions are realigned under the Chief, Internal Affairs.
