Subject: Transfer of Functions from the Office of the Solicitor

Sec. 1 Purpose. The purpose of this Order is to transfer to the Office of Inspector General the legal services now being performed by the Office of the Solicitor, Division of Audit and Investigation.

Sec. 2 Authority. This Order is issued in accordance with the authority provided by Section 2 of Reorganization Plan No. 3 of 1950 (64 Stat. 1262, 5 U.S.C. App.).

Sec. 3 Transfer of Functions. The legal services performed within the Division of Audit and Investigation of the Office of the Solicitor are hereby transferred to the Office of Inspector General.

Sec. 4 Delegations. The Inspector General is delegated, through the Solicitor, the authority to provide legal services for the Office of Inspector General.

Sec. 5 Administrative Provisions. The Assistant Secretary - Policy, Management and Budget will take appropriate steps to transfer the personnel, funds and property necessary to implement this Order. The Inspector General and the Solicitor will enter into, or modify, any agreements necessary to assure complete legal services for the Office of Inspector General.

Sec. 6 Effective Date. This Order is effective immediately. It will remain in effect until its provisions are converted to the Departmental Manual or until it is amended, superseded or revoked, whichever comes first. In the absence of the foregoing actions, the provisions of this Order will terminate and be considered obsolete on October 1, 1994.
