Subject: Realignment of Certain Functions within the Office of the Assistant Secretary - Policy, Management and Budget

Sec. 1 **Purpose.** The purpose of this Order is to realign the functions of the Office of Planning and Performance Management by placing that Office and its functions under the responsibility of the Deputy Assistant Secretary - Budget and Finance.

Sec. 2 **Authority.** This Order is issued in accordance with the authority provided by Section 2 of Reorganization Plan No. 3 of 1950 (64 Stat. 1262), as amended.

Sec. 3 **Realignment.** The Office of Planning and Performance Management and its functions are hereby realigned so that the Office is under the responsibility of the Deputy Assistant Secretary - Budget and Finance in the Office of the Assistant Secretary - Policy, Management and Budget.

Sec. 4 **Delegations.** The Deputy Assistant Secretary - Budget and Finance is delegated, through the Assistant Secretary - Policy, Management and Budget, all the authority necessary to carry out the responsibilities of the Office of Planning and Performance Management. These authorities may be redelegated.

Sec. 5 **Implementation.** The Assistant Secretary - Policy, Management and Budget is responsible for ensuring the implementation of this Order.

Sec. 6 **Effective Date.** This Order is effective immediately. It will remain in effect until its provisions are converted to the Departmental Manual, or until it is amended, superseded or revoked, whichever comes first. In the absence of any of the foregoing actions, the provisions of this Order will terminate and be considered obsolete on November 30, 1998.
