Subject: Realignment and Restructuring of the Main Interior Complex Security and Occupant Emergency Functions

Sec. 1 Purpose. This Order realigns the Main Interior Complex security and occupant emergency functions from the National Business Center and restructures the functions under the Deputy Assistant Secretary – Law Enforcement, Security and Emergency Management.

Sec. 2 Background. The Main Interior Complex security and occupant emergency functions in the National Business Center are realigned and restructured under the Deputy Assistant Secretary – Law Enforcement, Security, and Emergency Management whose responsibilities are expanded to include overseeing and coordinating security and occupant emergency functions in the Main Interior Complex. Integrating the Main Interior Complex security and occupant emergency functions with current law enforcement, security and emergency functions will facilitate improvements in physical security, law enforcement response, and emergency preparedness and response.

Sec. 3 Authority. This Order is issued under the authority of Section 2 of Reorganization Plan No. 3 of 1950 (64 Stat.1262), as amended.

Sec. 4 Organizational Change. The Main Interior Complex security and occupant emergency functions are realigned from the Deputy Assistant Secretary – Budget and Business Management, National Business Center, and restructured under the Deputy Assistant Secretary – Law Enforcement, Security, and Emergency Management. Responsibility for physical security, operational policies, procedures, and programs is placed in the Office of Law Enforcement and Security. Responsibility for occupant emergency plans and shelter-in-place procedures is placed in the Office of Emergency Management.

Sec 5 Delegation. The Deputy Assistant Secretary – Law Enforcement, Security, and Emergency Management is delegated all of the authority necessary to carry out the responsibilities described in this Order. This authority may be further delegated.

Sec. 6 Implementation. The Assistant Secretary – Policy, Management and Budget is responsible for implementing this Order, including the appropriate transfer of personnel, funds, programs, records, and property.

Sec. 7 **Expiration Date.** This Order is effective immediately. It will remain in effect until its provisions are converted to the Departmental Manual, or until it is amended, superseded, or revoked, whichever occurs first. In the absence of any of the foregoing actions, the provisions of this Order will terminate and be considered obsolete on December 1, 2010. The termination of this Order will not affect the organizational changes effected herein.
