Subject: Designation of Director, Minerals Management Service and Delegation of Authority

Sec. 1 **Purpose.** The purpose of this Order is to designate the Director, Bureau of Land Management, to perform the functions, duties, and responsibilities of the Director, Minerals Management Service, and to delegate all the authority necessary for such purpose.

Sec. 2 **Authority.** This Order is issued under the authority of Section 2 of Reorganization Plan No. 3 of 1950 (64 Stat. 1262), as amended.

Sec. 3 **Designation and Delegation as Director, Minerals Management Service.** Effective immediately, the Director, Bureau of Land Management, shall serve as Director, Minerals Management Service, and is hereby delegated, through the Assistant Secretary – Land and Minerals Management, all of the authority of the Director, Minerals Management Service, as set forth in Part 218 of the Departmental Manual.

Sec. 4 **Effect on Position of Director, Bureau of Land Management.** The Director, Bureau of Land Management, shall continue to perform any function or duty required by statute or regulation to be performed exclusively by the Director, Bureau of Land Management. This Order does not create a vacant office under the provisions of the Vacancies Reform Act, 5 U.S.C. §§ 3345-3349d.

Sec. 5 **Delegation of Non-Exclusive Functions and Duties of Director, Bureau of Land Management.** Any function or duty of the Director, Bureau of Land Management, that is not required by statute or regulation to be performed exclusively by the Director, Bureau of Land Management, is hereby delegated, through the Assistant Secretary – Land and Minerals Management, to the Deputy Director, Operations, of the Bureau of Land Management.

Sec. 6 **Expiration Date.** This Order shall remain in effect until specifically superseded.
