Subject: Designation of the Assistant Secretary – Policy, Management and Budget as the Director of Small and Disadvantaged Business Utilization and Realignment of the Office of Small and Disadvantaged Business Utilization

Sec. 1 **Purpose.** This Order designates the Assistant Secretary – Policy, Management and Budget as the Director of Small and Disadvantaged Business Utilization and realigns the Office of Small and Disadvantaged Business Utilization (OSDBU) as a direct report to the Director of Small and Disadvantaged Business Utilization.

Sec. 2 **Authority.** This Order is issued under the authority of the Small Business Act, 15 U.S.C. 631 *et seq.*, and Section 2 of Reorganization Plan No. 3 of 1950 (64 Stat. 1262).

Sec. 3 **Designation of the Assistant Secretary – Policy, Management and Budget as the Director of Small and Disadvantaged Business Utilization.** The Assistant Secretary – Policy, Management and Budget is hereby appointed and designated the Director of Small and Disadvantaged Business Utilization and is vested with the management of OSDBU. This designation includes the responsibility for implementing and executing the functions identified in the Small Business Act, as specifically set forth at 15 U.S.C. § 644(k). The OSDBU is hereby realigned under the management and supervision of, and in a direct reporting relationship to, the Director of Small and Disadvantaged Business Utilization.

Sec. 4 **Delegation.** The Assistant Secretary – Policy, Management and Budget is delegated all of the authority necessary to carry out the responsibilities of the Director, Small and Disadvantaged Business Utilization. This authority may be redelegated as necessary.

Sec. 5 **Implementation.** The Assistant Secretary – Policy, Management and Budget is responsible for implementing this Order, including the appropriate transfer of personnel, funds, programs, records, and property.

Sec. 6 **Effective Date.** This Order is effective immediately. It will remain in effect until its provisions are converted to the Departmental Manual, or until it is amended, superseded, or revoked, whichever occurs first. In the absence of any of the foregoing actions, the provisions of this Order will terminate and be considered obsolete on **October 24, 2012**. The termination of this Order will not nullify the organizational changes effected herein.
