Airtanker Base Closure

Discussion: The following information pertains to the Cedar City, Utah airport, Cedar City Airtanker Base, and the St. George, Utah Airtanker Base.

Cedar City (KCDC)

Runways 2/20 and 8/26 will be closed on Friday, July 17th at 6am. The runways will be closed to complete the asphalt markings, safety area grading, asphalt cleaning, light checks and the FAA Instrument flight check for the new construction. The airport management anticipates the reopening of Runway 2/20 on July 19th at midnight, if not sooner. A date has not been set for the reopening of Runway 8/26. Asphalt grooving of Runway 2/20 will occur during the month of August. Please check the Cedar City NOTAMs for updated information.

The Cedar City Airtanker Base is scheduled to open for fixed-wing operations on July 20th. Notification of the Cedar City Airtanker Base opening will be distributed through the dispatch center network as well as an email notification to the greater Interagency Aviation Management and Airtanker Base community on the day of reopening.

St. George Airtanker Base

The St. George Airtanker Base is scheduled to close at the end of the shift on July 19th
