Subject: General William J Fox Field (WJF) Lancaster, CA Runway and Taxiway Construction

Area of Concern: Aviation Operations

Discussion: The William J Fox Airport in Lancaster, CA is undergoing construction to Runway 6/24 at the intersection of Taxiway G. This improvement project has decreased the usable length of runway 24 to 3,500 feet.

A section of pavement approximately 10' x 20' has been removed near the intersection of runway 6/24 and taxiway G. A power cable also crosses the runway at this location. This may require aircraft to favor the North side of the runway.

Due to these issues **Fox Field Airtanker Base is not available for airtanker operations.** The completion date was July 1, 2016, but delays have pushed it into August.
