
Subject: Durango Tanker Base (KDRO) Taxi Way Construction

Area of Concern: Airtanker Base Operations

Distribution: All Aviation Users

Discussion: The Durango – La Plata Airport is scheduled to begin a construction project on Taxiway Alpha starting Tuesday, May 1st, the predicted completion date is Saturday, June 9th. The picture below shows the project limits, as outlined in light blue rectangle. Throughout the project the North 600 feet of Taxiway Alpha, Taxiway A1, and Taxiway Charlie will be closed. Aircraft wishing to depart on Runway 21 will need to back taxi from Taxiway A2 for a full length departure depicted as dark blue lines.

All aircraft will enter and exit the Tanker Base from the Southwest Entrance, Northeast Entrance will be closed. Be observant of construction equipment working next to the Base taxiway and ramp.
