SUBJECT: A-200, Mishap Review

On October 5, 2018, the online A-200 Mishap Review course will transition from an annually updated course package to an event driven update student selection format. Students taking the online version of the course on the <u>IAT site</u> will now be able to select individual modules based on year, aircraft type, and incident location.

Students will be required to watch 5 videos total within 14 days, 2 of the 5 presentations are required viewing. Progress is tracked for each video selected in order to ensure 100% of the selected video is viewed prior to it being recorded as complete. You are required to watch 100% of a video before it will be marked as completed. You will not receive credit if you fast-forward through a video. The "Take the Exam" link will appear once you have completed watching all 5 videos.
