WHO: COTA supported by partners in the Built Environment Taskforce


WHAT: Inter-island multi-modal transportation feasibility study and implementation project

- Aligns with complementary DPW 20-year Highways Plan, CEDS priorities, Primary and Secondary Road Risk Reduction, CPA Port, and CHCC expansion, capacity building, and planning efforts
- Critical systems redundancy
