## **DOI WILDLAND FIRE POLICY MEMORANDUM No. 2020-008**

**Purpose:** This Policy Memorandum (PM) provides guidance on the Fiscal Year (FY) 2020 third-quarter review of budget execution status for the Department of the Interior's (DOI) Wildland Fire Management (WFM) program. This policy applies to all activities funded by the WFM appropriation, except for Suppression Operations.

**Background:** The Office of Wildland Fire (OWF) is coordinating this review in order to formulate an objective assessment of the current status of budget execution in the WFM program and anticipate the impacts that the COVID-19 pandemic may have on program performance.

By taking a proactive approach to evaluating the progress of current activities, OWF and the DOI fire bureaus are committing to effective oversight and management of the WFM program in support of the Secretary's and Administration's priorities.

**Coordination:** Bureau Fire Directors and Fire Budget Leads were consulted in the development of this PM.

**Scope:** This PM applies to the Department of the Interior's bureaus and offices responsible for wildland fire management activities.

**Existing Policy Affected:** N/A

**Authority:** Departmental Manual Part 620 Wildland Fire Management

### **Policy:**

Bureaus are requested to use the FY 2020 Third Quarter Review Template (Attachment A) to provide a candid assessment of all activities, except for Suppression Operations.

Please provide one consolidated submission for each bureau. This is due to Thao Tran and Craig Leff no later than the close of business on Friday, July 17, 2020.

### **Third Quarter Review Submission**
