

VBA Footprint FY21

- **Compensation:** Paid **\$110 billion** to nearly **6 million** Veterans and survivors
- **P&F:** Paid **\$4 billion** to **351,000** beneficiaries
- **EDU:** Provided **\$11 billion** to **841,000** beneficiaries for all EDU programs
- **VR&E:** Paid over **\$1 billion** to **92,000** beneficiaries
- **LGY:** Guaranteed **1.44 million** loans totaling **\$447 billion**
- **Insurance:** Provided **\$1.2 trillion** in coverage to **5.7 million** Service members, Veterans, and family members
- **MDEO:** completed **1.66 million** compensation and pension (C&P) examinations under the VBA contracts
- **OTED:** **85,000+** Veterans reached through Solid Start

Honolulu VA Regional Office

To assist Veterans in American Samoa, CNMI, Guam and Hawaii:

- Placed permanent Legal Administrative Specialist (LAS) (Benefits Counselors) on American Samoa and CNMI in 1st Quarter FY22.
- The CNMI LAS is located on Saipan and travels to the Rota and Tinian monthly, the other two rural islands in CNMI.
- There are 5 LAS' in Guam to support the Veterans and Active-Duty Servicemembers.
- CNMI and Guam based LAS', facilitate monthly virtual Benefits Workshops for Veterans residing in and CNMI and Guam, using Cisco Webex.
- In the State of Hawaii, there are permanent LASs located on Oahu, Maui, and Hawaii (Big Island).
 - The Maui based LAS assists Veterans in Maui county and travels to Molokai and Lanai monthly.
 - The Hilo based LAS assists Veterans in Hawaii county.
 - A Honolulu based LAS travels to Kauai monthly and provide outreach.
- American Samoa and Honolulu based LAS', facilitate monthly virtual Benefits Workshops for Veterans residing in American Samoa and Hawaii islands, using Cisco Webex.
