Kodiak/Aleutians Subsistence Regional Advisory Council to meet in Cold Bay

The Kodiak/Aleutians Subsistence Regional Advisory Council will meet September 21-22, 2022, in Cold Bay at the Community Center. The meeting will begin at 8:30 a.m. daily.

The Council will discuss proposals to change Federal subsistence fish and shellfish regulations, fishery closure reviews, and other issues related to subsistence in the Kodiak/Aleutians Region.

The public is welcome to attend and participate in this meeting. To call into this meeting, dial toll-free (877) 807-6997 (passcode: 73803960).

In accordance with current federal guidance, Covid protocols will be based on CDC community levels (https://covid.cdc.gov/covid-data-tracker/#datatracker-home). In communities where the CDC community level is "high", all meeting attendees will be required to wear masks.
