

**Department of the Interior Highlights of the
Fiscal Year 2010 Energy and Water Development Appropriations Act**

On October 28, 2009, the President signed H.R. 3183 (P.L. 111-85). Highlights of the Act for Interior's programs include the following:

The Act funds Reclamation at \$1.09 billion, which is \$12.0 million above the 2009 enacted (excluding Recovery Act funding, which is excluded entirely for purposes of this summary) and \$67.0 million above the President's budget.

Water & Related Resources Account: The Act funds Water and Related Resources, Reclamation's primary operating account, at \$951.2 million, which is \$30.9 million above the 2009 enacted level and \$58.0 million above the President's budget.

The Act funds the following key projects as follows:

- **Arkansas Valley Conduit:** Funded at \$5.0 million. This was not funded in 2009 and not requested in the President's budget.
- **Central Valley Project:** Funded at \$133.8 million, \$9.3 million above 2009 enacted and \$509,000 below the President's budget.
- **Colorado River Basin, Central Arizona Project:** Funded at \$17.4 million, \$7.9 million below 2009 enacted and \$991,000 below the President's budget.
- **Colorado River Storage Project:** Funded at \$10.5 million, \$4.3 million above 2009 enacted and \$511,000 below the President's budget.
- **Klamath:** Funded at \$23.8 million, \$772,000 above 2009 enacted and \$1.2 million below the President's budget.
- **Klamath sedimentation (dam removal) studies:** Funded at \$1.9 million. Not funded in 2009 and \$103,000 below the President's budget.
- **Lower Colorado River Operations:** Funded at \$20.7 million, \$5.6 million above 2009 enacted and \$784,000 below the President's budget.
- **Navajo-Gallup Water Supply:** Funded at \$3.0 million. This was not funded in 2009 enacted and not requested in the President's budget.

- **Rural Water Projects:** Funded at \$121.3 million, \$18.0 million below 2009 enacted and \$57.3 million above the President’s budget.
- **Safety of Dams:** Funded at \$97.8 million, \$9.5 million above 2009 enacted and \$4.1 million below the President’s budget.
- **Water Conservation:** Funds the Water Conservation program at \$34.8 million, \$15.5 million below 2009 enacted and \$11.2 million below the President’s budget.

CALFED: The Act funds the California Bay-Delta Restoration program at \$40.0 million, the same as 2009 enacted and \$9.0 million above the President’s budget. The Act extends the current authorization for this program through 2014.

The Act funds the Central Utah Project at \$42.0 million, \$4,000 above 2009 enacted and the same as the President’s budget.
