Informational outreach meetings about the U.S. Department of the Interior Land Buy-Back Program for Tribal Nations will be held during the last week of January. The Buy-Back Program allows select individual landowners to receive payments for voluntarily selling their fractionated land interests. All lands sold in the Makah Tribe's jurisdiction will be transferred immediately to the tribe and held in trust. This will give the tribe an opportunity to use the land in a way that will benefit the community.

Meetings will occur on Wednesday, January 29, 2014 in Port Angeles, WA at the Lower Elwha Klallam Tribal Center. Another meeting will occur on Thursday, January 30, 2013 in La Push, WA at the Quileute Nation Tribal Council Building.

Landowners that have received offer packets should bring the whole packet to the meeting. Informational handouts will be available, as well as staff from Makah Realty Office, Office of the Special Trustee for American Indians, and the Land Buy-Back Program for Tribal Nations. They will also be able to answer any questions landowners may have about the Land Buy-Back Program and assist in executing the buy-back offer packets by having knowledgeable staff and notaries available.

Buy-back offers will be sent to landowners through the mail. For this reason, it is critical that landowners ensure their mailing address is current by calling the Trust Beneficiary Call Center at 1-888-678-6836.
