Subject: Dear Sirs/Madame Chairman, Salazer, and DOI administration:

As a member of a Federally, recognized Tribe in Oklahoma, Cheyenne/Arapaho, and as a person who received funds from the Keepseagle class-action which was just dispersed and an heir to the Cobell IIM Accounts in question, I am truly concerned about the Land in to Trust programs.

My mother was half-Cherokee and grew up owning a wheatfarm in Garber, Oklahoma all of her life. Her father was burned alive on a well built by Sinclair Oil Company and which was paid off with the settlement they gave my mom and Grandmother Simmering. When my mother died in 1998 after suffering from Colon cancer for five years and basically, starved to death, my husband and I wanted to buy out my brothers portion of the farm and we wanted to raise cows and still grow wheat.

However, since I was a Native American they denied our lown and told us that since we owned a house in another state we could not own my Mom's Farm. So, they sold it to a White man Mr Roggow and his wife Debbie and he had a brother who is a House of Rep. in Oklahoma over the Medicare dept and funneled the new owner \$500,000.00 annually. The highest paid subsidies to anyone in Oklahoma. Then, I got the records of my moms estate sent to me from her attorney's office after his death and a woman named Marrissa Lane has listed my mothers'kids as Lisa Ross, and two guys named Friez. My mom had six children, John, Marty, Gary Robin and Myself Candy, and my older sister Joy. The attorney did not file the estate papers correctly or gave the Tax Commission the wrong information after my mothers death. I called the attorney and she said she had a nervous breakdown at the time she was doing my moms papers. Then, I read about a Lisa Ross who is in the Rural Water Association Dept in Oklahoma and she was having all kinds of meetings with people concerning water rights. My mother Virginia Keys Colbert never sold her mineral right to her land so is Marissa Lane allowing Lisa Ross to be in charge of the water rights with my mom deceased? Gene Stipes was in a big scandal cause he hired ex-Senators to work as "Ghost Employees" of the Department of Human Services and go around and find out who own mineral rights to\ their lands and if it were theres or dead peoples property. They they would go in an confiscate that properties. Ms. Marissa Lane was a ombudsman who went to Nursing homes to help people with their estates after there death. I think this is Elder Abuse and fraud to the people involved even if it is after their deaths. Water Rights are important to tribal communities and Oklahoma and the Chicasaws are in dispute with the City of Oklahoma over water right now. I do think this is a fraud and should be treated as theft of mineral and water rts. I contacted my moms attorney but he died of Heart Attack in Feb last year.

Now Steve Olsen does not think it is his responsibility.

So I've written to the State Bar Association and the Attorney General so they are aware of the problem. If this is possible , to steal some ones mineral rights and land rights after there death, they why have an attorney? Its just free for all. Thank you, for letting me vent what I have been dealing with these last several years. We did get back a settlement of \$50,000.00 for the discrimination of Native Americans from the USDA.
