My name is Scott Sucher, and I am the former project manager for the Indian Land Consolidation Project. I held this post for all seven years of operations. As such, I have been intimately involved in every aspect of acquisitions, from the rather mundane decisions to those that drove it at the strategic level.

The announcement from last week that all appeals are exhausted indicate that Cobell Settlement activities are about to increase. There may be some lessons learned from previous operations that could help in making the decisions to come.
