To: The Designated Natural Resource Trustee Officials for the Deep Water Horizon Oil Spill

To implement and effectuate the Natural Resource Damages Assessment, Early Restoration and the broader Restoration planning processes, negotiations, and other matters which may arise with respect to the Deepwater Horizon Oil Spill, the undersigned Designated Natural Resource Trustee Official (the DNRTO) for the United States Department of the Interior (DOI) makes the following designations pursuant to Sections VI and VII of the Memorandum of Understanding Relation to the Natural Resource Damage Assessment and Restoration Resulting from the Deep Water Horizon Mobile Offshore Drilling Unit and the Subsea Macondo Well (the MOU) among the State and Federal Natural Resource Trustees for the Deepwater Horizon Oil Spill. The following individuals are identified in accordance with Sections VI and VII of the MOU:

- (1) The primary point of contact for the Executive Committee of the Trustee Council shall be Cynthia K. - (2) The alternate Trustee Council Executive Committee representative shall be the undersigned, Kevin Reynolds, Deepwater Horizon Case Manager, U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, 1875 Century Boulevard, Atlanta, GA 30345; phone: (404) 679-7292; fax: (404) 679-7081; email: kevin_reynolds@fws.gov.
- (3) In the absence of Mr. Reynolds or myself, John Carlucci shall act as DOI's Trustee Council's representative. - (4) The legal counsel assigned to advise DOI's Trustee Counsel representatives shall be Harriet (Holly) M. For efficiency and in order to effectuate decisions and voting as may be required on any matters within the scope of the MOU, including for purposes of Section VIII, I, as the DNRTO for DOI, acknowledge and agree that I shall serve as the representative on the Executive Committee of the Trustee Council and shall act as the principal representative of DOI's natural resource trusteeship. Mr. Reynolds shall act as the alternate on the Executive Committee in my absence. If I and Mr. Reynolds are absent, Mr. Carlucci shall so serve and act. As the AO, I may name other and/or additional replacement alternates to serve in this capacity. Legal counsel assignment may be changed as deemed necessary by DOI.
