Dear Mr. Hinesley and Mr. Brown: Please find attached a request that your office review and respond to a determination by the Department of the Interior and the National Atmospheric Oceanic Administration that certain proposed early restoration projects related to the Deepwater Horizon Oil Spill are consistent with the ACAMP. The projects will only be selected after publication of a plan and public comment, but the named federal trustees are seeking expedited review because the projects, if selected, will be fast tracked as early restoration to accelerate restoration of resources and services impacted by the Spill. We respectfully request an expedited review and a response to this determination of consistency and thank you in advance for your efforts to accommodate this request.
