

USEITI Candidacy Application Subcommittee
Meeting Summary for Thursday, June 6, 2013, 2-3pm

Background Document

- The rough draft of the background document needs more work before it is ready to send to the Multi-Stakeholder Group (MSG) for review.
 - Interior will continue to work on the document to incorporate information from the Bureaus of Indian Affairs and Land Management at Interior, the Department of Energy, and state data from government and civil society sector members. Subcommittee will hold off providing redline edits until the next draft is circulated by Interior.
 - Government and Industry sectors will work together to consolidate lists of federal revenues payors to help identify corporate ownership and numbers of companies that may fall within materiality thresholds.
- To facilitate discussions about materiality and scope at the upcoming MSG meeting on June 12-13, relevant charts in the draft background document will be included in the meeting materials and presentations by the government sector.
- The subcommittee will review and provide redline edits on the next draft between June 20 and July 3. Subcommittee members will form a small writing team to work through the redlines and put together a cleaner draft to come back to subcommittee and send to the MSG by July 16th a week before next meeting (July 23-24).

Legal Analysis

The government sector will provide a legal analysis for USEITI at the MSG meeting June 12-13. The other sectors did not expect to conduct their own legal analyses.

Options for Engaging States

- The subcommittee will recommend to the MSG that USEITI undertake adapted implementation for subnational reporting, providing publicly sourced narrative about states' revenue data with a process for states to opt-in to the federal USEITI process.
- Government sector members will provide an overview of considerations for including states, and civil society members will give a presentation about publicly available data by state.
