


USPP has re-secured the Lincoln Memorial and NAMA maintenance crews are in the process of replacing the bike rack.

The Jefferson Memorial is secured.

MLK Memorial is currently being re-secured.

USPP and NAMA rangers are in the process of assessing how much bike rack remains at the WWII Memorial and will re-secure the memorial once the first amendment demonstration is over.
