

Museum Emergency Salvage Cache Recommended Supplies and Equipment

Emergency Cache Box: Water-tight heavy plastic tool box, bin, or storage chest. Models with handles and wheels are best. The box should be large enough to store all your unit's museum response supplies and equipment. An emptied cache box can be used to transport museum collections. Stock your cache box with the following tools, supplies, and equipment:

- First Aid Kit
- Hard Hats
- Leather Work Gloves (heavy-duty, various sizes)
- Nitrile Gloves (examination gloves)
- Rubber Gloves (heavy-duty)
- Safety Goggles
- Respirator Masks
- Tyvek Coveralls (various sizes)
- Rubber Boots (various sizes)
- Sponges (large)
- Cotton Towels and Rags (various sizes)
- Plastic Sheeting
- Shrink-wrap
- Tarps
- Spill Kit
- Tool Kit (with all basic hand tools)
- Mover's Blankets
- Disinfectant/Sanitizer
- Flashlights (water-resistant)
- Flood Lights
- Flood Lights, battery-powered, rechargeable
- Battery Charger
- Rechargeable Batteries (extras for flood lights)
- Extension Cords (outdoor)
- Duct Tape
- Caution Tape
- Mop and Bucket
- Batteries
- Wet/Dry Vacuum
- Other supplies and equipment, as needed at your unit
