



Gap analysis of services we provide in the Pacific and the USVI

We have identified an opportunity to outreach those veterans living in St. John, as they need to take a ferry to St. Thomas.

We are in the process of evaluating the best options to offer services in that island.

Overarching Issues in the USVI

The following issues/concerns are common throughout the Caribbean for both VA and other healthcare providers:

- ✓ Improved access to medical care services.
- ✓ Availability of accredited healthcare facilities for specialty care.
- ✓ Limited number of trained healthcare professionals.
- ✓ Travel is expensive (airfare) for veterans not otherwise eligible for beneficiary travel support.
- ✓ Significant expenditure of funding for both non-VA provided care and beneficiary travel support.
- ✓ Continued identification/enhancement of distance technology/telemedicine to extend the reach of VA services.

Overarching Issues in the USVI

✓ Language Barrier

The VA Caribbean Healthcare System has established priority for all USVI Veterans visiting the San Juan VA Medical Center. The patients are given the name of the Special Programs clerk and are oriented by the staff at both St Thomas and St Croix, to make contact with the fully bilingual clerk upon arrival to the Hospital.

The patients are familiar with this program and understand that if they have a problem of any kind, including language related, the patient and staff at any of the outpatient clinics, can contact the Special Programs clerk. Upon check in at the Special Programs office, they are given the extension written on a “Fast Pass” ticket, so that they can reach the office for assistance.

With the “Fast Pass” ticket, they are seen in the morning whenever possible and check out as quickly as possible to avoid travel mishaps.




