### **RECOVERY ACT GUIDANCE**

The following information serves as guidance for Recovery Act funding labels, based on language in the Office of Management OMB memorandum (M-09-10).

#### **Office of Management and Budget (OMB) Memorandum**

*Section 1.5 of M-09-10 states:*

**For grant and cooperative agreement awards, agencies MUST:**

- Include prominent “Recovery Act” labels and tags in funding opportunity synopses.
- Full funding opportunity announcements, and award notices that clearly distinguish them as “Recovery Act” actions.

### **GRANTS.GOV SUGGESTIONS**

The following actions are suggested in order to satisfy the OMB guidance when posting a Recovery Act (ARRA) opportunity:

1. Use the term “Recovery Act (ARRA)” within the “Opportunity Title.”
2. In the “Opportunity Category” choose “Other” and add “Recovery Act (ARRA)” in the “Category Explanation” text box.
3. In the “Activity Category” choose “Other” and add “Recovery Act (ARRA)” in the text box.

### **CFDA RECOVERY ACT IDENTIFIERS**

Another identifier will be the new Recovery Act CFDA numbers. Grants.gov will add these new CFDA numbers as we receive them from GSA.
