

## FY2011 PERMANENT WORKFORCE DISTRIBUTION



# FY2011 DOI Representation


## Compared to National Civilian Labor Force



Data as of 9/30/2011. DOI permanent workforce is 89% general schedule employees; with 51,739 employees in grades GS-5 through SES.


# FY2011 DOI Accessions by Race/Ethnicity/Gender
