
Dear Ms. Port:

In reference to Bruce Blanchard's letter of April 13, 1988 regarding CERCLA natural resource trustee agencies, I would like to provide your office with the name of the designated Government of Guam agency which will serve as trustee for the Territory of Guam's natural resources.

Please be advised that the Bureau of Planning, specifically the Coastal Zone Management Program within that agency, will serve as principal trustee for Guam's natural resources for the purpose of CERCLA activities. However, other Government of Guam agencies such as the Guam Environmental Protection Agency, Department of Parks and Recreation, Port Authority of Guam, Department of Agriculture, and the University of Guam will play key roles in supporting the efforts of the Bureau of Planning as the principal trustee.

I look forward to working with your office on this important aspect of the CERCLA program.
