Indirect Methodology

✓ Not a "rate" but a methodology

 Consistent approach - Single method for calculating indirect costs across the Service

Calculated on a quarterly basis



Indirect Methodology

Indirect costs are derived from direct work Direct cost categories are predefined Specifically developed to support Spill Response and NRDAR



Foundation for Defining Cost

Statement of Federal Financial Accounting Standards #4

Direct Cost

- Costs that can be specifically identified with an output
 - Salaries and benefits for employees who work directly on an output
 - Supplies and materials used to support an output
 - Various costs associated with space, equipment, facilities, utilities, etc. that are used <u>exclusively</u> to produce the output

Indirect Cost

- Costs of resources that are jointly or commonly used to produce two or more types of outputs but are not specifically identifiable with any output
 - General administrative services; general research and technical support; security; rent; employee health and recreation facilities; and operating and maintenance costs for building;, equipment; and utilities



Cost Documentation

 Specifically developed for Spill Response and NRDAR
Consistent throughout the Service
Costs pulled directly from FWS Financial System
No ability to manipulate costs
