







Number of Indian Water Rights Settlements by Year of Federal Legislation




Indian Water Rights Settlements with Federal Legislation, by State




Number of Years between the Appointment of a Negotiation Team and the Establishment of an Implementation Team




Active Indian Water Rights Settlements by state




Total Annual Discretionary DOI Settlement Implementation Funding (nominal \$)




Total Mandatory/Discretionary DOI Settlement Implementation Funding (nominal \$)




Bureau of Indian Affairs Funding for Indian Water Settlement Negotiations




Total and Federal Settlement Costs, by Settlement, Chronological Order, Real \$2012
