Aniak Area Post-Season Subsistence Fishery Harvest Household Surveys.

Abstract: The Alaska Department of Fish and Game Subsistence Division, in partnership with the Kuskokwim Native Association, directed household surveys in Aniak during October-November 2002 to collect subsistence fish harvest data for the previous period of March 1, 2002 through September 30, 2002. The survey identified households that subsistence fished; estimated the number of salmon and non-salmon fish harvested for subsistence; identified gear used for each species harvested along with harvest locations for hook and line; and documented household perceptions of subsistence salmon fishing quality.
