Yukon-Kuskokwim Delta Subsistence Regional Advisory Council Meeting and Public Hearing to be Held on a Federal Subsistence Special Action Request

There will be two public meetings held on Fisheries Special Action Request FSA14-03 at the Yuut Elitnaurviak-The People's Learning Center in Bethel, located at 610 Akiakchak Drive, on April 7 and April 8. The first meeting will be with the Yukon-Kuskokwim Delta Subsistence Regional Advisory Council at 10:00 a.m. on April 7. The second meeting, a public hearing, will be held starting at 1:00 p.m. on April 8.

At the meetings, the public will have the opportunity to provide testimony and comments to the Regional Advisory Council and representatives of the Federal Subsistence Management Program as part of the decision-making process. Comments will be forwarded to the Federal Subsistence Board for its consideration on the special action request.

Fisheries Special Action Request FSA14-03, submitted by the Napaskiak Tribal Council, asks the Federal Subsistence Board to close the Kuskokwim River drainage to Chinook salmon fishing except for Federally qualified subsistence users, and to conduct an analysis under Section 804 of the Alaska National Interest Lands Conservation Act (ANILCA).
