Federal Subsistence Board to Hold Work Session in Anchorage

The Federal Subsistence Board will hold a work session Wednesday, July 30, beginning at 8:30 a.m. in the Gordon Watson Conference Room located in the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service Region 7 Office, 1011 E. Tudor Road, Anchorage, Alaska. During the work session, the Board will discuss its annual report replies to the Regional Advisory Councils; discuss the status of the Memorandum of Understanding with the State that is set to expire in November 2014; finalize the Board field trip details to the Kuskokwim drainage and other issues related to Federal subsistence management. Additionally, during an executive session closed to the public, the Board will discuss the Regional Advisory Council nominations and develop recommendations to the Secretaries of the Interior and Agriculture for appointments.
