## **The North Slope Subsistence Regional Advisory Council to Meet in Barrow**

*In conjunction with public meeting on Proposal to Revise Rural Determination Process*

The North Slope Subsistence Regional Advisory Council will meet March 17-19, 2015 at the Inupiat Heritage Center in Barrow. The meeting begins at 9 a.m. daily.

The Council will develop proposals to change Federal subsistence hunting and trapping regulations and discuss other issues related to subsistence in the North Slope Region. Following the meeting, on March 17 from 7-9 p.m., there will be an opportunity for the public to submit comments on the proposal to revise the rural determination process.
