

### **Ketchikan Student Wins Subsistence Student Art Contest for 2015**

ANCHORAGE – Reilly McCue, 9, of Ketchikan is the winner of the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, Office of Subsistence Management’s sponsored subsistence art contest for 2015. Reilly’s drawing depicts a colorful and intricately patterned crab framed over water. Her work will serve as the cover art for the 2015-2017 Subsistence Management Regulations for the Harvest of Fish and Shellfish on Federal Public Lands and Waters in Alaska book distributed statewide.



The Office of Subsistence Management received over 290 art entries from students all over the state of Alaska in grades K-12. The artwork was judged by the chairs of the Federal Subsistence Regional Advisory Councils and Federal Subsistence Board members during the month of February. The student art will be used in regulation books, brochures and other publications produced by the Office of Subsistence Management.
