

**2016 Yukon River Fall Salmon Fishery News Release # 24
Yukon River District 2 Commercial Period 7
Districts Affected: Lower Yukon Area
Emergency Order # 21**

The 2016 fall chum salmon preseason run projection, based on the summer chum to fall chum salmon run size relationship, is for a run size between 800,000 and 900,000 fish. This level of abundance should be sufficient to provide for escapement, an above average subsistence harvest, and a surplus available for commercial and personal use purposes. The estimated fall chum salmon passage at the mainstem sonar near Pilot Station through August 8 is 451,900 fish, which is above the historical median of 279,300 fish for that date.

District 2 Commercial Fishing:

Commercial fishing will be open for one period in District 2 on Wednesday, August 10 from 12:00 noon until 8:00 p.m. This will be an 8-hour commercial fishing period with gillnets restricted to six-inch or smaller mesh size.

Verbal reports from the District 2 commercial opening on August 7 indicate a preliminary harvest of 4,574 fall chum and 455 coho salmon from 83 deliveries. The cumulative commercial harvest in District 2 to date is 74,106 fall chum and 1,051 coho salmon.

District 2 Subsistence Fishing Schedule:

Subsistence salmon fishing in District 2 is open during the fall season 7 days per week, 24 hours per day with gillnets restricted to a maximum mesh size of 7.5 inches, except for 12 hours before, during, and 12 hours after each commercial fishing period. In District 2, subsistence salmon fishing will close at 12:01 a.m. Wednesday, August 10, and reopen at 8:00 a.m. Thursday, August 11.

Fishermen may use 4-inch or smaller mesh size gillnets to target non-salmon species during subsistence salmon closures.
