- Invitation to Micronesia








Invasive Species and Islands

Islands are more vulnerable

- Have low species diversity, but higher % endemism than continents.
- Species tend to have evolved in the absence of predators.
- "Empty niches"
- Endemics have small populations with restricted distributions.

- DOD-Funded \$3.5M
- Comprehensive Plan
 - Covers Entire Region
 - All Ecosystems, Taxa
- Phase 1:
 - Risk analyses, port assessments
 - Recommendations and BMPs
 - NISC Coordination
 - 4 Federal Departments and Regional Partners

Phase 2:

- Competitive grant awarded to University of Guam
 - > UOG, SPC, Landcare NZ, others
- Phase 2 Components
 - Independent scientific review
 - > Strategic Implementation Plan
